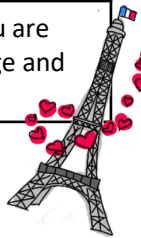


SKILLS DEVELOPED

| Year 9 Survival Top Tips | |
|--------------------------|---|
| Tip 1 | Learn and revise vocabulary regularly, approximately 10 words a week |
| Tip 2 | Carry a pocket dictionary and look up words you aren't sure of |
| Tip 3 | Little and often revision: aim to do 5-10 minutes of practice a day |
| Tip 4 | Create flashcards of vocabulary per unit that you study, on cards or online |
| Tip 5 | Understand why you are learning the language and be inspired by it! |
