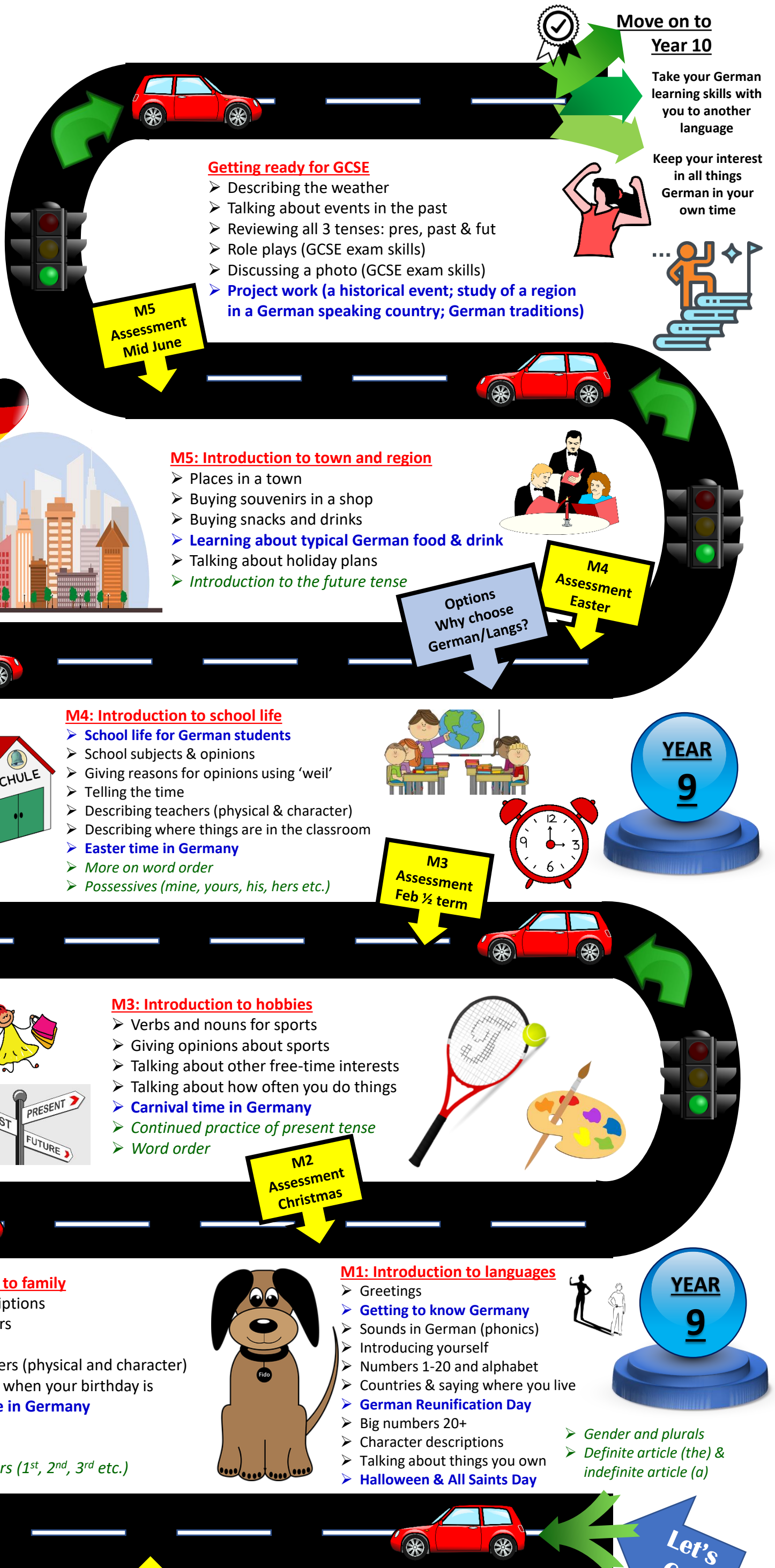


SKILLS DEVELOPED

Year 9 Survival Top Tips	
Tip 1	Learn and revise vocabulary regularly, approximately 10 words a week
Tip 2	Carry a pocket dictionary and look up words you aren't sure of

Tip 4	Create flashcards of vocabulary per unit that you study, on cards or online

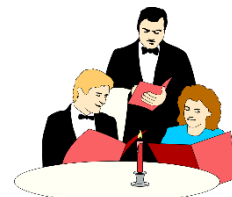

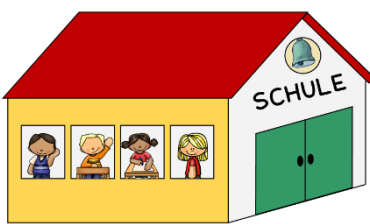

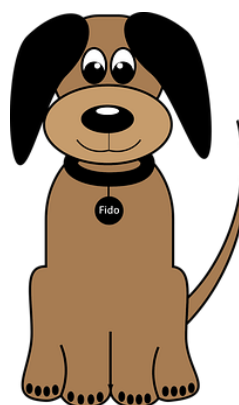
